


- 1) Two or six microcentrifuge tubes containing 1 mg of Streptavidin
- 2) One or three microcentrifuge tubes containing less than 5 mg of Reagent A
- 3) One or three microcentrifuge tubes containing a solution of less than 5 mg of Reagent B
- 4) A bottle containing 4 or 12 mL of Buffer A
- 5) A bottle containing 10 or 30 mL of Buffer B
- 6) A bottle containing 4 or 12 mL of Storage Buffer (phosphate buffer saline)
- 7) A bottle containing 4 or 12 mL of Solution A
- 8) A plastic bag containing centrifugal filter devices, desalting columns, agarose beads, and microcentrifuge tubes.
